

Creating your graphic and text presentation

1) Bring a camera to the interview. Make sure you have consent of interviewee to take photographs. If so, ask interviewee to sit for portrait. Often, interviewees will have ephemera spread out. You can take photos of this with permission and, if it seems reasonable, can also insert into graphic design to create collage.



2) Using non-web-based word processing or graphic design software, upload image(s) to create design. View <https://www.instagram.com/spohp/> to see an example from SPOHP's "50 Years, 50 Faces" campaign. Programs should allow you to layer text (such as interviewees name) and other design elements. Design help can be found in tutorials found from a Google search.



3) Copy the image you have created using the design software and paste it to a Word doc. Add your vignette ("a short descriptive literary sketch") below image—two to three paragraphs capturing interviewees story. See emailed example for ideas. Submit this to course file.
